Drip Irrigation Systems for Supplemental Water

Protect Your Investment

Supplemental water will be necessary for at least 3-5 years while plants establish. Installing a drip irrigation system is a highly recommended moisture conservation technique to help ensure optimum plant growth and deep root establishment. Some of the benefits of using a drip irrigation system include; only a small area of soil near the plant is wetted, very little water is lost to evaporation. Most importantly, plants aren't stressed by the too-wet, too-dry cycle of other methods.

Land Preparation and Spacing

The land should be cultivated and fallowed in the fall prior to planting the windbreak. Weed control of the planting is very important to maintain tree survival. Effective windbreaks and living snow fences can be obtained with 1-3 rows of shrubs and trees with proper design and installation.

The Uinta County Conservation Districts Tree Program enables landowners to obtain trees at nominal cost. The purpose of the program is to encourage landowners to plant effective wind barriers to protect buildings, cropland and feedlots and for erosion control, streambank stabilization, reforestation, and other conservation plantings.

These trees cannot be resold as living trees (the roots must be severed). The order form must be completed in full and all information be legible.

Plan Before You Plant

A planting plan should be prepared before trees are ordered or planted. The planting plan will show the proper location for the planting, the best species for your site, spacing between rows, spacing between trees in the row and the correct number of trees and shrubs needed. The plan will also point out requirements for proper planting to gain initial survival and how to keep trees in a vigorous growing condition. CONDITIONS OF SALE

- 1) Nursery stock is not intended to be used in ornamental or landscape plantings, it is to be used for conservation purposes only.
- 2) Seedlings are sold in the quantities listed on this form; lots will not be broken to facilitate the sale of individual seedlings.
- 3) Payment must accompany order; no trees will be reserved until payment is received.
- 4) Trees are living organisms that require proper care; there can be no guarantee of survival.
- 5) All orders are final; No cancellations or refunds.
- 6) No plant purchased from the Uinta County Conservation District or their distributors may be resold as a living plant.
- 7) In the event that trees orders are unavailable, a refund MAY be offered unless a substitute species can be arranged.
