

Idaho blue-eye grass

Scientific name: *Sisyrinchium idahoense*

This plant is not a grass as the common name implies. This plant is part of the Iris family (Iridaceae) which includes many of our showy garden plants like Iris, Crocus and Gladiolus.

Blue-eyed grass has small attractive deep blue-violet flowers with a yellow center. It can be found flowering from May to mid-summer in ephemerally moist areas. The leaves and stem are flattened and remain green throughout the summer.
