You are solely responsible for maintaining your private well. Knowing the water quality of your well is the first step in protecting your family.

Taking your sample on June 14 is critical as some tests must be analyzed within a short holding time.

Important Dates to Remember

- ★ Must **pre-register** by Wednesday, **June 1**, including which test option you would like — call 787-3070 or register online. **Payment is due at time of pre-registration.**
- ★ **Bridger Valley**-pick up your sampling kit from the UCCD Office June 7-10, 13, from 8am—4pm.
- ★ **Evanston** -pick up your sampling kit from the UW Extension Office during their business hours June 7-10, 13.
- ★ **Sample your water on June 14** and bring the sample back to the Conservation District or the UW Extension Office in Evanston the same morning you sample. All samples must be back to one of these locations **before** 11:00 am on June 14!

Samples must be collected the morning of June 14 and brought to the drop off location before 11 am. UCCD will then put them on ice and take them to the lab in Rock Springs to ensure the samples arrive at the lab within the holding time.
